Becoming a foster parent is challenging yet immensely rewarding. If you've thought about fostering a child or teenager, here are a few reasons to follow that tug on your heart.



- ### 1 You'll protect a child.

Children or teenagers placed in foster care have often experienced abuse or neglect. When you become a foster parent, you're giving a child hope by providing them with stability and compassion when they need it most.
- ### 2 We'll make sure you're matched with the right child.

DCCCA places much care on our placement services. We ask you about your preferences, so we can ensure the best possible experience for both you and the child. When we contact you regarding a potential placement, we will provide you with as much information as possible so you can make the best decision for your family. You always have the final say.
- ### 3 We give you all the support you need.

In addition to 24/7 support, respite care, and personalized child matching, DCCCA pre-service training teaches you how to care for children who may have been abused, neglected, or otherwise mistreated. You'll also get medical training in first aid, medication administration and universal precautions. All training is at no cost to you.
- ### 4 Have you already taken in a child you know? You, too, can become a licensed foster parent.

If you've taken in a child family member, you're a kinship foster parent. Maybe things happened so quickly you couldn't fully prepare, but your compassion compelled you to immediately protect the child. We commend your heart and would love to provide you with additional support to make this experience easier for both the child and your family.
- ### 5 The reward outweighs the heartache.

Maybe you're already thinking about the gut-wrenching feeling of saying goodbye when a foster child leaves your home. DCCCA foster parents tell us their care for the child far outweighs any sadness they feel for themselves.
